Announcement of Consultant Positions or probation internships at the CPM of Yaoundé, Cameroon

Ladies and gentlemen,

We are pleased to announce that our Center for Psychotraumatology and Mediation (CPM) in Yaoundé has launched a competition for the recruitment of health professionals since July 1, 2021. The advertised positions are listed on our website: www.ipm-cmr.org , please read it.

Candidate selection procedure:

1. First step:

Upon receipt of the applications, candidates will receive a test by individual email psychotechnical assessment to go online and return to us immediately.

2. Second step:

Only a minority of candidates will be invited to the online interview by Skype. Fluency in English and French (spoken) will be an added advantage.

3. Third step:

Only applicants who are interviewed by Skype will have a hands-on exercise with a video of a patient with mental health issues who is undergoing an assessment interview with the supervising psychiatrist at IPM-Internal. The evaluation plan will be taken with you during the evaluation, so no need to bring your sheets or your pen to take notes, everything will be given to you on site.

At the end of the video interview, your dictation on the smartphone will be transmitted electronically by our email address: admin@cpm-ipm.org and copies @ info@ipm-int.org & jb.potcho@psy-scan.ch;

You will be judged by your dictation, clearly audible by our secretariat during the transcription of your evaluation according to the CPM Template. Your transcribed dictation will be evaluated by our jury by comparing it with the standard dictation found in the patient files that you will attend the video evaluation made by the examiner. The Jury awaits your dictation by email within a maximum of 12 hours and the speed of reception of dictation will be a positive criterion in the selection.

4. Fourth step:

A contract will be established and signed at the end between IPM Cameroon and the candidates selected for a period of probationary training and continuing training and practical postgraduate course ranging from 6 months to 12 months.
